I have a very special photo saved in my phone from June 15th, 2025. That was the day that our family crossed the state line into Wisconsin as we made our move from Texas.

Shannon and I took a picture standing at the “Welcome to Wisconsin” sign to commemorate the moment. We were confident that God had called us to Spring Creek Church, but even in our joy, we were uncertain about what the future would hold once we arrived.

Over the past year, though, God has truly done so much more than we could have imagined. Because of your generosity and hospitality, we feel at home.

You have welcomed us into your homes and your lives. You have prayed for us, encouraged us, and helped us in every possible way as we have adjusted to our new community and our new church family.

WEEKEND WORSHIP

Where people encounter Jesus and take their next step.

Each week, more than **2,200 people** gather to worship, open Scripture, and take their next step.

Over the past year, **average Sunday attendance has grown by 15 percent.**

But more significant than growth in numbers is growth in commitment.

164 individuals stepped into **membership**, choosing to fully invest in the life and mission of the church.

99 people publicly declared their faith through **baptism**. Among them were men and women of all ages, including **47 adults, 40 students,** and **12 children.**

These aren't isolated moments.

They are part of a bigger story God is writing.

Nearly **6,000 people** gathered for **Good Friday** and **Easter, 5,700** people for **Christmas Eve**, and **2,800** for **Amerifest.**

Each of these moments created space for many to encounter Jesus, some for the very first time.

This is what it looks like when a church isn't just growing in numbers, but helping people follow Jesus.

Following Jesus begins early and it grows over time.

At Spring Creek, we are intentional about creating environments where kids and students can take their next step with Jesus at every stage of life.

Each week, more than **330 children** gather in KidsCreek. Learning who Jesus is through engaging worship, hands-on teaching, and consistent care.

That foundation continues through Awana, where more than **250 kids** are learning Scripture, building friendships, and growing in their understanding of God's Word.

These environments are supported by over **170 volunteers**, who are creating spaces that are safe, welcoming, and grounded in truth.

GROUNDING IN TRUTH FROM THE BEGINNING.

And this year, that investment led to real steps of faith for our kids and students.

45 students and **12 kids** publicly declared their faith through baptism. More students are already preparing to take this step in the coming season.

This is what it looks like when faith becomes their own.

It's not just about a moment. It happens over time, through consistent investment, meaningful relationships, and a community walking alongside the next generation every step of the way.

FAITH MADE THEIR OWN. LIVED WITH CONVICTION.

As students grow, faith becomes more personal.

Each week, **375 students** gather in The Loft. Surrounded by **70 adult volunteers** who know them, support them, and challenge them to follow Jesus.

Through teaching, D-Groups, and shared experiences, they are learning how to understand Scripture, discover their identity in Christ, and live out their faith.

Throughout the year, key moments create space for deeper relational and spiritual growth.

390 students and leaders participated in the Fall Retreat, stepping away from daily rhythms to intentionally encounter God.

371 students and leaders participated in the Winter Retreat, creating space to deepen their faith and connect in community.

FAMILY CARE MINISTRY

Building stronger marriages & families.



At Spring Creek, we believe the primary place of spiritual formation is in the home. Discipleship doesn't stop at church doors. It continues in the home.

This year, we launched the Family Care Ministry.

It is a focused effort to strengthen marriages, equip parents, and help build homes centered on Jesus.

Through **Marriage Matters**, couples are being encouraged and equipped to build relationships marked by commitment, resilience, and Christ-like love.

Through the **Parent Project**, parents will be gaining practical tools and encouragement to lead their children spiritually with confidence and consistency.

At the center is a simple rhythm for everyday life: **Word. Worship. Blessing. Mission.** A pattern designed to help families follow Jesus together, not just in moments, but in the normal rhythms of home.

This vision is supported through **mentoring, care,** and **intentional community.** It ensures individuals and families that they are known, supported, and not walking alone.

To form disciples in homes. The place where faith is best lived, practiced, and passed on.

GOD IS CHANGING LIVES

I was raised in church and attended regularly throughout my childhood and adolescence. During my senior year of high school, I struggled with depression. It was during that time that I was introduced to the idea of Jesus Christ as my Savior. My uncle told me that I only needed Jesus. I didn't fully understand it then, but his words stayed in the back of my mind.

Over the next few years, I made some poor decisions and drifted away from church, attending only on holidays or special occasions. I felt disconnected and found it easy to ignore my faith altogether.

In May 2005, a friend invited me to Spring Creek Church. I had already heard good things, but nothing prepared me for that first Sunday. I attended with my husband, and the experience moved me deeply. The worship, the message, and even seeing my husband singing touched my heart. I was overwhelmed and even found myself in tears, which is not something I do easily.

It didn't take long for me to make a decision. That summer, at the end of a service, I accepted Jesus Christ into my heart.

Since then, my life has changed. I look forward to church each Sunday. I pray more, spend time reading my Bible, and have a growing desire to live differently.

The Life Group I joined quickly became like an extension of my family. It has brought consistency, encouragement, and a sense of belonging that carries through my entire week.

I know that no matter what I have done or what I may face in the future, Jesus Christ is my only salvation. And I look forward to the day I can thank Him face to face in heaven.

CARE & SUPPORT

Walking with people through every season.



At Spring Creek, we believe every person matters. And because of that, every person belongs.

That includes individuals and families walking through difficulty, uncertainty, and seasons where life feels heavy.

Care is a vital part of discipleship.

Through groups like **Financial Peace University**, **DivorceCare**, and **GriefShare**, individuals found support in seasons of loss, transition, and financial strain, creating space for honesty while reminding people of the hope found in Jesus.

Our **Disability Ministry** reflects this commitment in a powerful way.

70 individuals with disabilities and their families are actively part of our church community. Not on the margins but fully included.

Each week, a core Disability Ministry team of **25 dedicated volunteers** builds consistent, trusted relationships, while more than **100 volunteers** across the month help create an environment marked by dignity, care, and belonging on Sundays and beyond.

We are a church that strives to reflect the heart of Jesus in what we say AND how we care.

ADULT DISCIPLESHIP

Formed by truth, shaped in community, sent to make disciples.

At Spring Creek, we create environments where **faith is formed over time**. It's not just learned but lived.

Across our Life Groups and Men's and Women's Ministries, that formation happens every week through **Scripture, community**, and intentional **investment in one another**.

Following Jesus is never meant to be lived alone.

That's why we continue to help adults find places to grow, belong, and take meaningful next steps.

People are building relationships that strengthen their faith and encourage faithful living.

This is where truth becomes personal, community becomes spiritual family, and disciples are equipped to **follow Jesus in everyday life**.

THESE AREN'T JUST PROGRAMS.

They are pathways where people open Scripture, build relationships, and grow into lives marked by obedience to Jesus.



WOMEN ROOTED IN TRUTH. GROWING TOGETHER.

This year, more than **1,200 women** stepped into one of **10 Bible studies**.

They gathered regularly to open God's Word, deepen their faith, and encourage one another in every stage of life.

425 women participated in **Rooted**, and **750 gathered** for the **REAL Conference**. They experienced renewal, connection, and spiritual growth.

MEN GROUNDED IN TRUTH. CALLED TO LEAD.

At the same time, men across our church are stepping into environments designed to ground them in truth and call them to leadership.

Nearly **300 men** engaged in Bible-driven classes. More than **180 participated** in focused studies like Psalm 101 and Finishing Strong, committing to grow in their understanding of Scripture and applying it to everyday life.

Beyond structured environments, growth is reinforced through relationships.

Others gathered through events and retreats, with more than **800 participants** across the year.



FOLLOWING JESUS TOGETHER.

One of the most meaningful ways people take their next step is by stepping into community.

This year, more than **400 people** gathered weekly in one of our **17 Life Groups**, opening Scripture, sharing their lives, and building relationships where faith becomes personal.

For many, this is where something shifts.

Where attending becomes belonging.

Where faith moves from something you hear to something you live.

Alongside Life Groups, we've continued to create additional pathways for growth and care.



Through **7 topical classes**, over **130 people** each week are stepping deeper into their understanding of Scripture and what it means to follow Jesus in everyday life.

These are the spaces where relationships are formed, burdens are carried, and faith is lived out together.

Because taking the next step with Jesus doesn't happen in isolation.

It happens in community, over time, one step at a time.

MISSION & OUTREACH

Bringing the hope of Jesus here, near, and far.



Following Jesus doesn't end with us. It sends us.

At Spring Creek, we believe every person is invited to be part in the mission of God. Joining Him in what He is doing here, near, and far.

This calling is for all of us. This year, that response has taken shape in meaningful ways.

Through **Operation Christmas Child**, **10,716 shoeboxes** were packed and sent around the world.

Each one represents a child receiving not just a gift, but an opportunity to hear the gospel and begin a journey of faith.

36 adults served on mission trips to Albania, Ecuador, and Spain. Taking the message of Jesus across cultures and contexts.

36 students also stepped into **global mission** through their own trips, while over **195 students** participated in **Serving Saturdays**, learning firsthand what it means to live out their faith beyond what is familiar.

Beyond these moments, we continue to support a growing network of missionaries serving both locally and around the world.

They are faithfully proclaiming the gospel and making disciples in diverse cultures and contexts.

These are not just initiatives, but steps of obedience.

Steps that move faith beyond belief into action. Steps that reflect a church learning to live sent.

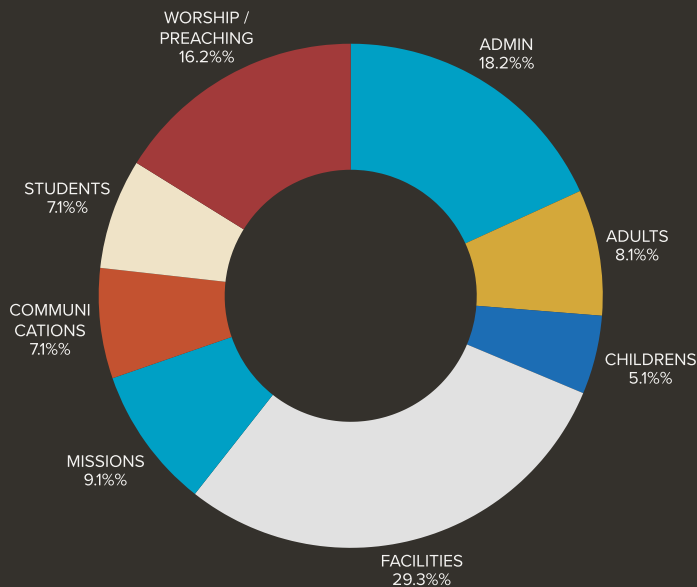
This past year, your generosity has made a tangible impact. It has created environments where people can gather each week to worship and hear the gospel. It has supported ministries that are discipling the next generations.

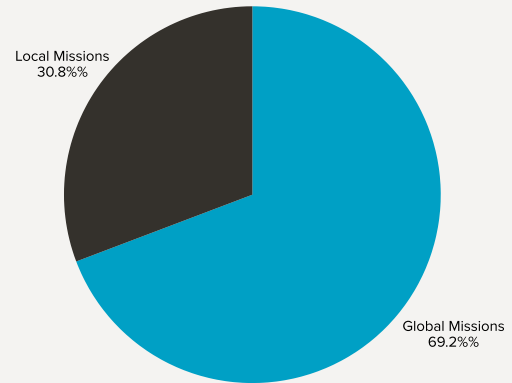
